The present hourly rate is £275 per hour.

The standard minimum fee is £85.

We reserve the right to vary the rate in matters of particular urgency and/or complex or unusual matters or those that require particular expertise.

In addition to our fee, there will also be other costs related to your matter which have to be paid to third parties.

These include legalisation fees paid to the Foreign and Commonwealth office and/or a relevant foreign Embassy, translators/interpreters fees, agent's fees, courier's fees and/or special postage charges. You are responsible for all payments made on your behalf. Such costs will only be incurred once we have obtained your prior consent to do so.
